ALES Bus Rules

Students must be on time at the designated school bus stops and should wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before walking up to the bus. We want to ensure that all students arrive safely to and from school, so please remember that loud talking and laughing will distract from the driver and make safe driving difficult. Horseplay is not permitted around or on the school bus.

- 1. Good behavior is expected just like it is in the classroom.
- 2. Be courteous. Do not use inappropriate language.
- 3. Do not eat or drink on the bus.
- 4. Help keep the bus clean.
- 5. The bus driver is in charge; follow the driver's instruction.
- 6. Do not write on or damage the bus.
- 7. Stay in your seat.
- 8. Keep your head, hands, and feet inside the bus.
- 9. Bus Driver may assign seats.
- 10. Do not leave books, lunches, or other things on the bus.
- 11. Do not throw anything in the bus or outside the window.
- 12. Be very quiet when the bus is at a railroad crossing.
- 13. Aerosol sprays are not permitted on the bus.
- 14. All students walking on the front (bus loop) and cafeteria sidewalks must remain on the building—side of the yellow lane until it is safe to enter the vehicle or building.

As stated in Board of Education policy 7340, a student who is disorderly and insubordinate on a bus may have his or her transportation privileges suspended.
