MATH UPDATE - This week in math we learned how rotating an array 90 degrees helps us learn *related* facts using the commutative property of multiplication. We also learned how to find the product of a more difficult multiplication fact by "chunking" arrays and finding the answer to two easier facts and then adding or subtracting our answers (the distributive property of multiplication). We continue to practice skip counting and using the "count-by" method to solve multiplication problems. We even sang a new version of Jingle Bells to help us with our multiples of 3!
