
Music is written on a staff.

A staff has 4 spaces.






Fill the blanks.

Half Note hears a sound. It may be a musical tone. Or it may just be noise. Half Note listens carefully. It is a tone!

A tone has a certain pitch. The pitch of a tone means how high or low it is on the musical scale. There are eight tones in the major scale. These eight tones are called an octave. The eight tones have names. From lowest to highest, the tones in an octave are do, re, mi, fa, sol, la, ti, do.

Directions: Somehow Half Note lost an octave. Now the eight tones are mixed up with many other words and syllables. Can you find the names of the eight missing tones? Circle the name of each tone. Be sure to find and circle two "do" tones because it is both the lowest and highest tone in the octave.
