Welcome! This year you will explore the elements of art as you develop your drawing and painting skills. You will also develop your personal style as you learn how to see, think, and respond like an artist. We will explore a variety of traditional drawing and painting media this year and get to know some influential artists.

<u>What will I learn?</u>

What will I learn?

You will need to bring your <u>charged</u> laptop, a sketchbook, and a pencil to every class. You <u>may</u> use your phone to find references instead of your laptop as long as you have access to Microsoft Teams and your student email. You are also encouraged to bring an **apron or** old t-shirt with you to class to protect your clothing.

<u>What will I need to bring?</u>

Projects will make up the majority of your grade in this class. Each project is worth 100 points and will be graded using a rubric that will be given to you at the beginning of each project. It is important that all work is submitted on time! Incomplete work will not earn a passing grade. Work that is late will not be accepted if it is not complete. Projects that are complete, but are submitted late, will suffer a deduction of 5 points each day that they are late. No work may be submitted after the last day of any quarter; <u>No exceptions</u>.

How will I be graded?

You are responsible for your materials and for the maintenance of your personal and shared workspaces, At the beginning of the year, you will be assigned a drawer for the storage of your work and materials. Drawers must be cleaned out at the end of each project. Missing and/or damaged materials may need to be replaced by the student.
