You will be introduced to a few new materials, artists, and artworks. You will also enjoy a little more artistic freedom while exploring new concepts and designing for new art challenges!

What will I learn?

What will I learn?

You will need to bring your laptop, sketchbook, and a pen or pencil to every class. You will not need your phone. You will use your laptop to find references, so make sure it's charged daily! Phones may not be out during class without teacher approval.

What will I need to bring?

Most of the points you will earn in this class will be from major projects. Each project will have a rubric with different requirements, but they will all be worth 100 points. You will be notified at least 5 days before a project is due.. In addition to projects, a variety of "skills challenges" and participation points may be assigned. It is important that all work is submitted on time! Portfolios and assignments that are more than 5 school days late will only earn up to ½ credit (50%). Incomplete work will not earn a passing grade. Work that is late will not be accepted. If it is not complete! No work may be submitted after the last day of any quarter.

How will I be graded?

You must be responsible for maintaining your materials and spaces! At the beginning of the year, you will be assigned a drawer for the storage of your work and materials. Drawers must be cleaned out at the end of each project. Missing and/or damaged materials may need to be replaced by the student.

What is expected of me?

Just as you are responsible for materials and workspaces, you are also responsible for keeping track of due dates and your grades as you complete projects and assignments. If you have questions or want to talk about the grades entered in PowerSchool, message me in Teams and schedule a time that we can talk privately.

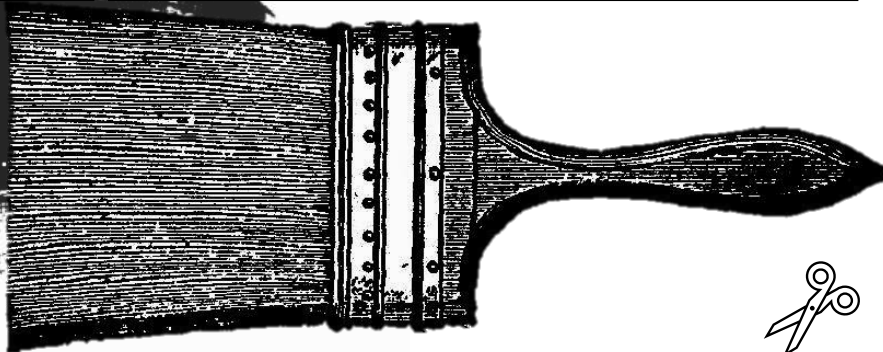
What is expected of me?
