GATOR Folder: Your student will bring home a green GATOR folder each day. This folder will contain important information, homework, etc. Please ensure it is checked each night and returned to school each day. If sending a note or labeled money to school; these items should be put in the student's GATOR folder as I will check it each morning.

## **Grading Policy:**

Each marking period, we strive to grade I2 assignments. Assignments that come home with percentage points will be used as a graded assignment. Assignments that come home without a percentage grade will have been checked for completion or accuracy!

#### Homework:

Homework will NOT be mandatory unless your child needs extra practice in a certain area. Practice pages that are sent home are expected to be completed and returned. Please know that homework should be completed independently, but I do ask that you look over their work for any obvious errors.

Students will have an <u>optional</u> reading log to complete each month. When a student reads for 10-15 minutes or practices their sight words, they may color in one item on the reading log. When it is completed at the end of each month, it may be returned for a prize! I do always encourage practicing spelling words and math facts each night! ©

We will discuss our classroom rules extensively during the first few weeks of school and revisit them as needed throughout the year!

Individual Incentives - Class Dojo Points
Table Group Incentives - Game Board Pieces
Whole Class Incentives - Smiley Jar

I do use Class Dojo as a behavior management tool. Students are able to earn points for various things such as helping a friend, giving a compliment, participation, etc. However, students may also lose points for interrupting learning or not following one of our classroom rules. Students will get 3 warnings before losing a point. On the 3<sup>rd</sup> time, students will lose a point. One point is equal to 5 minutes of quiet, reflection time. When students earn 20 Dojo points, they can go to our Classroom Dojo Store and pick out a prize!

Each table group has the opportunity to earn rewards based on following our 4 classroom rules. Each time the table collectively follows the rules, they move their game piece on the board from Start to Finish.

The whole class can earn a smiley face in our jar when we receive a compliment in the hallway, cafeteria or from a specials teacher.

Reward incentives will always be primarily voted on by the students. It is important that they have choice and voice to ensure the reward has a positive and influential impact.
