Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent to conditionally appoint Ashley Malpiedi, who holds Permanent New York State Teaching Certificate in the School Counseling as a Guidance Counselor in the Counseling tenure area for a three (3) year probationary period to commence on August 10, 2019 and end on August 10, 2022. Eligibility for tenure at the end of the probationary period is dependent on Ashley receiving APPR ratings of Effective or Highly Effective in 3 of the 4 preceding years and no Ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year. The expiration date of this probationary appointment is tentative and conditional only. In order to be eligible and considered for tenure, the Guidance Counselor must meet all requirements of education law and corresponding regulations. The salary will be paid in accordance with the salary schedule outlined in the collective bargaining agreement with the Allegany-Limestone Teachers' Association and the Board of Education based upon Schedule B, Step 12. Initial Certificate as, is hereby appointed to a probationary position in the Elementary Principal tenure area for a four year probationary period commencing on July 24, 2019 and ending on July 24, 2023 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012 of Education Law, in order to be granted tenure the Principal must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the Principal receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period, the Principal shall not be eligible for tenure at that time.
