ALES Bus Rules

Students must be on time at the designated school bus stops and should wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before walking up to the bus. We want to ensure that all students arrive safely to and from school.

- 1. The Bus Driver and Bus Monitor are in charge.
- 2. Seating may be assigned by the Bus Driver or Bus Monitor.
- 3. Be cooperative and courteous and remain seated facing forward.
- 4. Follow directions while waiting for and entering or exiting the bus.
- 5. Classroom rules and conduct apply on the school bus.
- 6. **DO NOT** eat or drink on the bus.
- 7. Keep the bus clean.
- 8. Do not throw anything on or out of the bus. Use the trash can.
- 9. Riders must not tamper with the bus or its safety devices.
- 10. Remain 100% quiet when approaching Railroad Crossings.
- 11. Never extend anything outside the bus windows.
- 12. Dangerous/Hazardous materials must not be brought on the bus.
- 13. Do not forget or leave any personal items on the bus.
- 14. Students are responsible for bus swipe cards (scanning on and off).
- 15. All students walking on the front (bus loop) and cafeteria sidewalks must remain on the building—side of the yellow lane until it is safe to enter the vehicle or building.

As stated in Board of Education policy 7340, a student who is disorderly and insubordinate on a bus may have his or her transportation privileges suspended.
