

We are ready and eager to greet you when you return to Allegany-Limestone Middle-High School!

Please understand that we will seek to simplify or change any procedure if it needs improvement.

Before arriving at our school:

1. ALCS Student Daily Health Check-In: Complete the health survey for every student coming to ALMHS. The link: <https://checkin.caboces.org/>
Follow the directions because you will first have to REGISTER. You can register BEFORE the first day of school.
2. Do not send a student who is ill or who has a fever.
3. Grab a mask (or two!).
4. If riding a bus, masks must be worn at all times.

Arriving at our school:

There will be signs and adults to assist in this process for anyone who is confused.

1. Grades 6 and 8 students will enter school at the far-right door at the front of the building.
2. Grades 7 and 10 will enter through the MS main doors. (These doors are now our MAIN entrance doors.)
3. Grades 9, 11, and 12 will enter through the former HS main doors.
4. Students will wear masks as they enter and whenever they walk throughout the building.

Entering our school:

1. Students will quickly be screened for their temperature through a temperature scanner or reader. A second reading may be taken if a student presents a higher than normal temperature.
2. If anyone registers a temperature greater than 100 or is displaying symptoms of illness, the student will walk with an administrator or other designated adult down to our Student Health room where the nurse will evaluate and then, if needed, contact families for student to return home.

Inside school:

1. Masks must be worn at all times when students are traveling throughout the halls and while in bathrooms.
2. Teachers will provide instruction on mask wearing and procedures within their classrooms.

Dismissal from school:

1. Our dismissal will begin at 2:45, but students will be released according to the method of transportation home.
2. Students leaving by car will be excused first through the doors they entered in the morning.
3. Bus riders will then be excused.
4. Please review with your child that he or she should not be congregating in groups while waiting for transportation. Social distancing needs to be followed. Masks need to be worn. **Administrators, SRO, and other designated adults will be assisting and supervising.**
5. We may add another exit door in the future if needed.
